Local Youth Win Fishing Tournament



Twelve charter boats and 50 teens caught striped bass to 39 inches, bluefish to 15 lbs and big black sea bass scup in the 6th Annual Fan Pier Youth Fishing Tournament to benefit Save the Harbor/Save the Bay on August 11th.

This year's tournament rased more than \$10,000 to support Save the Harbor/Save the Bay's youth environmental education programs, which have connected more than 125,000 underserved youth and teens from more than 100 youth development organizations in 40 communities to Boston Harbor and the Boston Harbor Islands since they began in 2002. Included in this year's tournament a "juniors" division with six kids from the South Boston Neighborhood House, who caught black sea bass and scup with Captain Charlie Gibbons and first mate Stripper Sam aboard the belle.
